## Torah - Lifestyle not Religion

There is cheesecake and all night learning; blintzes and Megilas Rus; Hallel and Yizkor. Strikingly, on Shavuos, there are no special mitzvos. The laws of Pesach fill volumes with the removal of chametz, the laws of the Seder and requirements for matza. Rosh Hashanah has its shofar, Sukkos its sukah and arbah minim, but Shavuos seems bereft. Where do we find meaning and inspiration? Where are the infamous minutiae so necessary for personal growth?

It would seem that the answer lies in the study of Torah. After all we stay up all night studying. Isn't that the resolution to our mystery? Studying Torah must be the mitzvah of Shavuos. This is z'man matan Toraseinu!

The problem is, there is no more of a mitzvah to learn on Shavuos than any other time of year (except for the almost universal custom of learning through the night). In fact we learn as a sign of appreciation for the magnificent kindness bestowed upon us by the Creator at Sinai, but what are we actually celebrating?

We are celebrating the culmination of an initial process. The Omer has been a process of personal growth and development that began when we experienced our personal exodus at our Seder tables. Since then we have been preparing to receive the Torah at Sinai. We have been preparing for something far more meaningful than a religion. We have received a way of life, a meaning and direction for our minute-to-minute lives - A path to greatness and closeness to the Ultimate Source of all Good. Such a celebration cannot and must not be distracted by a "ritualistic" mitzvah. Shavuos is the celebration of true life and freedom. Something so great and universal that we attempt to show our appreciation with extra hours of study. Extra hours geared towards awareness of our purpose, direction and obligation.

Yet, we must remember that true acceptance of Torah has two stages. The first, perhaps hardest, is the enlistment to the Tzivos Hashem. The Torah, long before any one group adopted this name as their motto, called us Hashem's army. However, like every soldier, there is sacrifice of individual "freedoms" and identity to conform to the orders and regulations of the armed forces. This, in truth, is an illusion. *Ein cheirus elah Torah*, there is no freedom apart from Torah. In reality, there are numerous expressions of growth through Torah and they are all valid. The "ladder" of growth and development can be seen in many of its varied forms in Talmudic passages, Rishonim and Acharonim. Each path is unique, but each path leads to the ultimate goal of closeness to Hashem.

As we learn all night this Shavuos, let us not forget to commit ourselves to act on Hashem's behalf by learning throughout the year and by strict adherence to His commandments. By so doing, we may merit to celebrate His Torah in His land with His House rebuilt in Yerushalayim, speedily, in our days.

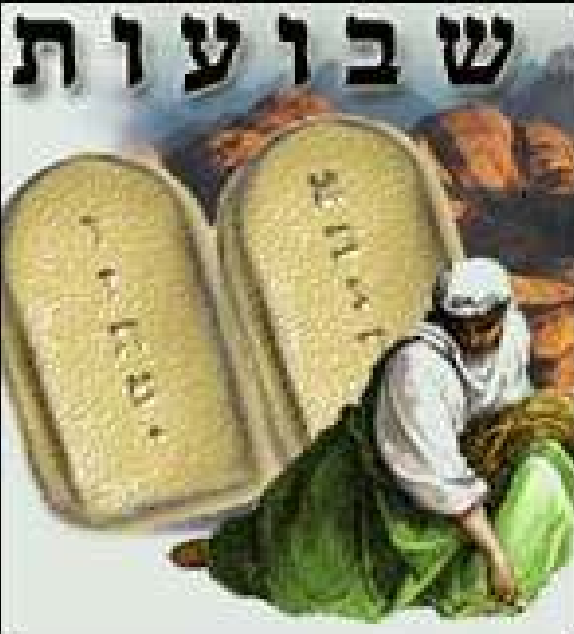
