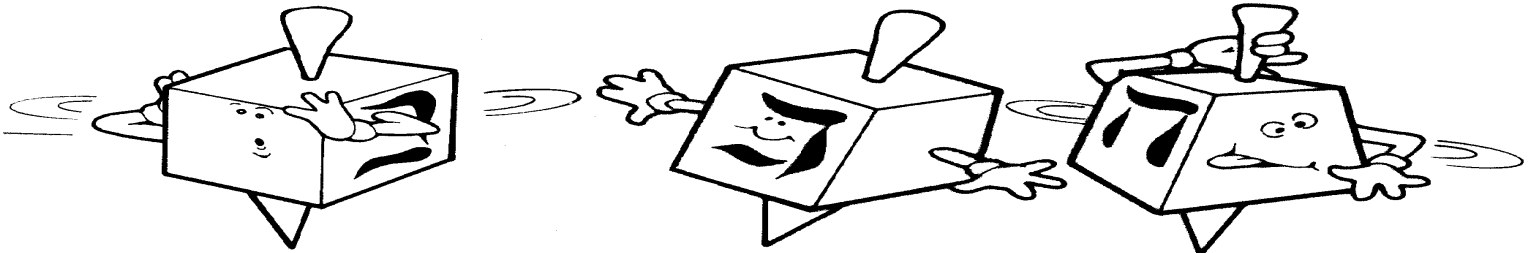
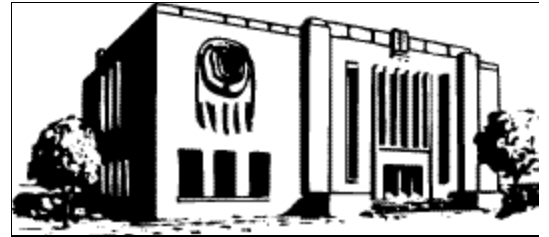

T In Those Days – At This Time

His phrase could be read homiletically: how do we see what happened “then” in comparison to “now”. There is some resemblance in the fact that the struggle of the Chashmonoim against the Greeks took place in our land. The other holidays on our calendar celebrate salvatory events, either in foreign lands or at least in a hostile desert.

On the other hand the nature of the current struggle is totally different. In the special prayer of thanksgiving inserted in the Shmone Esrei during Chanukah, we thank Hashem for delivering “the mighty into the hands of the weak”. The roles are reversed Boruch Hashem but have become almost as problematic. We are fighting the power of the underdog. We share that problem with the greatest power today, the superpower USA. The US is resented worldwide. It is scrutinized every step of the way and has the liberal community sympathizing with regimes and people they would normally despise. We the “little super power” in the Middle East suffer from the same problem. We are resented worldwide (of course we have the additional problem of Historic Anti-Semitism) and our “underdog” the Palestinians, receive sympathy widely including from a whole

genre of people who really are ideologically opposed to all that Palestinians and all the Middle Eastern nations do and stand for.

What is also still true to a great extent is the phrase, “the wicked in the hands of the righteous” (Halevai). We do not say that our enemy is all wicked and we are all righteous. Amongst them are undoubtedly many who would prefer to live in peace; and many sincerely believe they have a legitimate claim to the land. There are things we have done over the years which may not pass all tests of decency. But certainly we, more than many of those who criticize us now, have made every effort to act with justice and compassion as much as it possible in the face of extreme provocation and we have succeeded fairly well.

May Hashem grant us victory “in this time” as He did in “those days” and allow us to rebuild the Bais HaMikdash, speedily in our time, Amen.

Laws and Customs of Chanukah

It is preferable to use olive oil because the miracle in the Temple occurred with olive oil, but other pure, clean oils or candles may be used.

It is preferable to light the Menorah near a window that faces the street.

On the first night, one candle is lit on the extreme right end of the Menorah. Every subsequent night, one candle is added towards the left. The newest candle added that evening, on the left is kindled first, moving to the right!

The time for lighting candles is immediately upon nightfall (time of Sabbath end). One is not permitted to do anything other than recite the Maariv prayer before lighting the Menorah. If one is accidentally prevented from lighting candles at that time, one can still do so as long as the household is awake. Beyond that, one can no longer recite the blessings.

On the eve of the Sabbath, Chanukah candles are kindled prior to the Shabbos candles but care should be taken to have sufficient oil or candles large enough to burn a half hour past nightfall. Saturday night at home the candles are lit immediately after Havdalah.

Chol Hamoed Pesach 2003 marks the 10th Yahrzeit of the "Rav", Rav Joseph Dov Soloveichick ztzl, Rosh HaYeshiva of Yeshiva Rabbeinu Yitzchak Elchanan for many years and spiritual leader of Modern Orthodoxy. The year 2003 also marks the 100th Anniversary of his birthday.

The Rav was one of the greatest Jewish scholars and thinkers of the 20th Century and unique in the depth and breadth of his intellect. Over the decades he was the "Rebbi" of hosts of students, many of them becoming outstanding scholars and thinkers in their own right.

We are dedicating a special Shabbat Iyun in his memory which will be led by one of his outstanding and brilliant disciples.

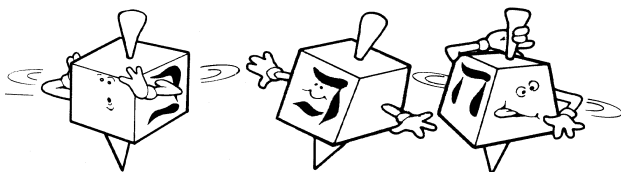

I wish to express heartfelt thanks for the great effort that you spent in order to raise money for the bullet-proof vests sent our way. My children and grand-children all live in settlements, so needless to say, these vests are so greatly appreciated!

The young ones and married ones felt secure upon the receipt of the vests, but particularly the army men in our family showed outward admiration for the fine quality of the finished product and were pleased with the various pockets, marks, and position of these compartments.

Ultimately, when trying on the vests, they were suddenly oblivious of my presence, and their reactions, I felt, should be shared with you.

My husband and I and Rabbi Shafir, the Rabbi of the settlement, Ofra, were also involved at the expanded "mission" in organizing contributors for some of the poverty-stricken

families in Ofra. Unemployment has left so many people in distress. It is really noble on your part and on the part of your congregants who came forth at these times and showed concern in a practical way for the families.

Many of these people are proud and under ordinary circumstances would not agree to receive support. Their difficult situation brought them to consent to worry for their children and they more than appreciate your kind attention.

Please convey our personal thank-you to the Community and to yourself. These are not easy times for Israel. Lectures and accomplishments, the kind of which you extended to us, give strength!

Let us hope for peaceful sleep, but smiling, and let us hope for G-d's mercy on His people.

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The Hebrew Free Burial Society

The Hebrew Free Burial Society has been functioning for many years, providing dignified burial services for indigent Jews. Over the years, the organization has upgraded its procedures which now follow the rules of our religious tradition of Kovod Hameiss completely.

Surprisingly enough, in our society today it is still very much needed – Either due to lack of funds, lack of relatives or unfortunate disinterest.

T'hara, burial according to Halacha and even a respectable Matzeva is provided. Halacha designates such unfortunate individuals as "Meiss Mitzvah".
