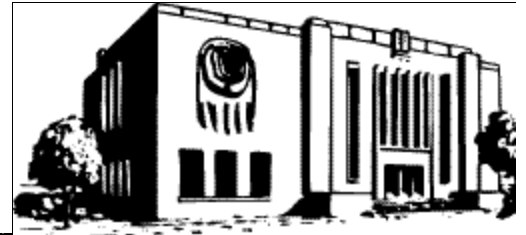

The “Nine Days”

Rosh Chodesh Av falls on Wednesday, July 10, which marks the beginning of the “9 days” during which mourning for the destruction of the Temple is intensified. Therefore, we are forbidden to eat any meat or fowl or drink wine, except on Shabbos and as specified in the Shulchan Aruch. It is also forbidden to bathe oneself or wash clothing except as specified in the Shulchan Aruch.

Tisha B’Av

Tisha B'Av (the ninth day of Av) is the day which saw the entire city of Jerusalem in the hands of the enemy and the Bais Hamikdash in flames. It has, therefore, become a national day of mourning and fasting. Tisha B'Av is different from other fast days in that it begins at sundown of the 8th and continues to the night of the 9th. This year the 9th of Av falls on Wednesday night, July 17 and Thursday, July 18.

Shoes and sandals containing leather may not be worn in the 25 hour period. Whenever possible, work is curtailed, and it is customary not to sit on chairs until midday. It is forbidden to bathe; it is also forbidden to greet one another.

Some of the prohibitions are usually extended until midday of the following day, the 10th of Av, such as eating meat, drinking wine, washing clothes and cutting one’s hair. But this year, since the 10th is Friday, these prohibitions are suspended in honor of Shabbos.

Kashrus Alert

We strongly urge our members and friends to check appropriately when booking simchas or any other events for kashrus supervision.

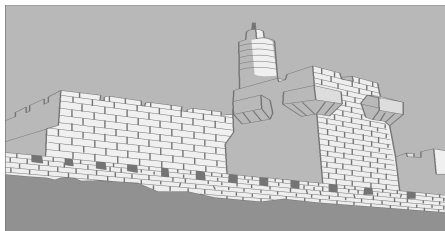

It is a wonderful collection of pithy comments rooted in classical sources and buttressed by real life stories on the Torah narratives of Sefer Bereshis.

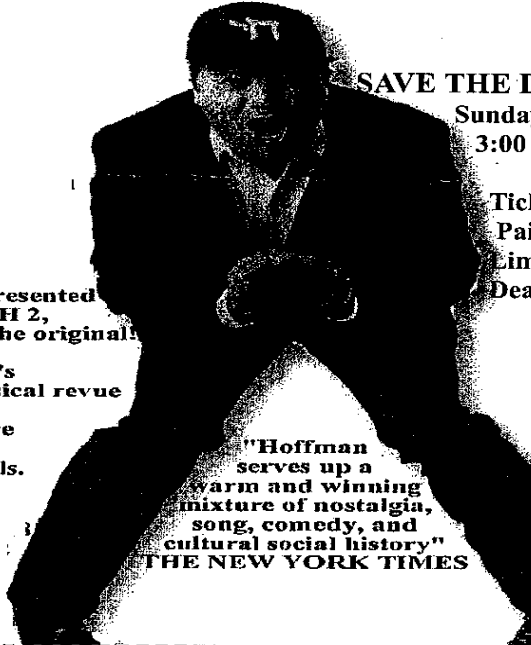

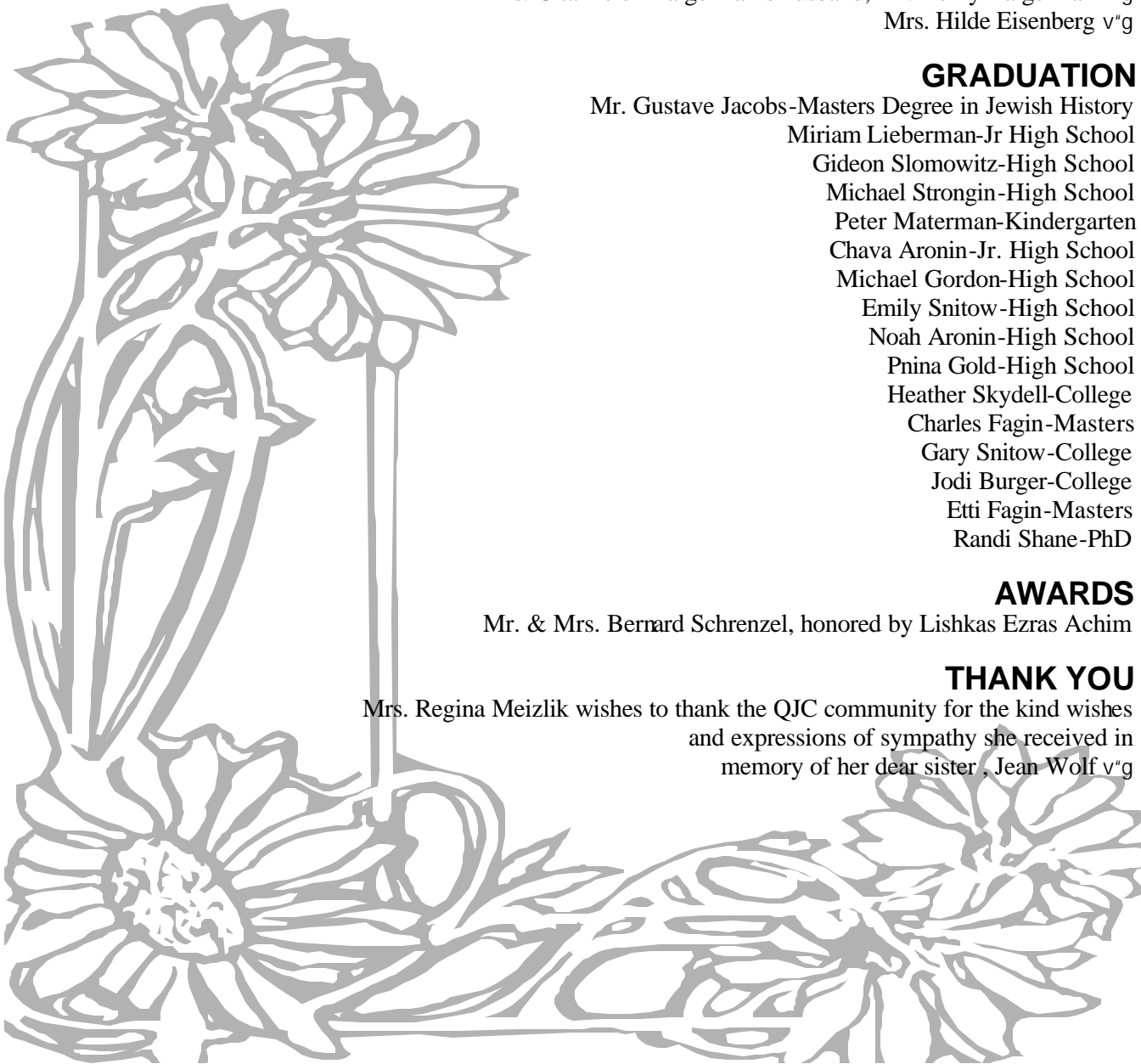
